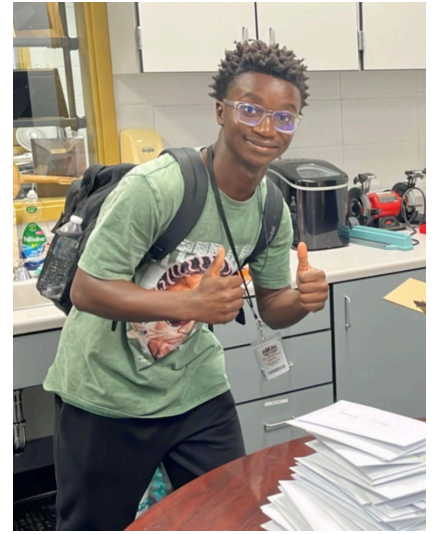

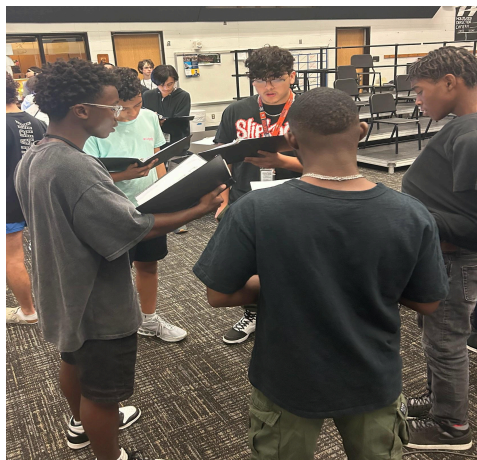
All-State Contest

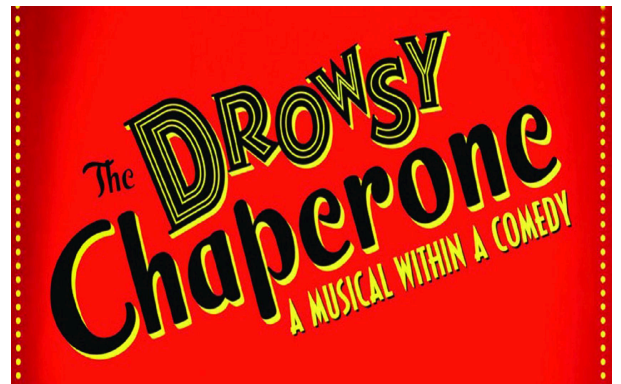
Musical Packet Meeting

BOY Forms & Fees

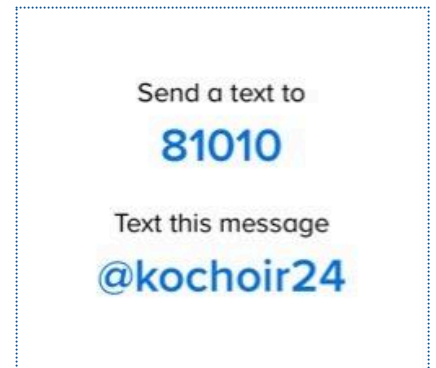
Every year, we require our students and parents to fill out an acknowledgment form for reading our handbook and fill out medical information for our students. These things have been posted in Schoology and also [HERE](#). **These forms are now two weeks late and we are still missing around 8 of these forms!**

This year's choir fee is \$70 and has been uploaded to SchoolCashOnline. This fee covers the cost of clinicians, accompanists/musicians, organization apparel, required entry fees, hospitality, office supplies/other equipment, and
