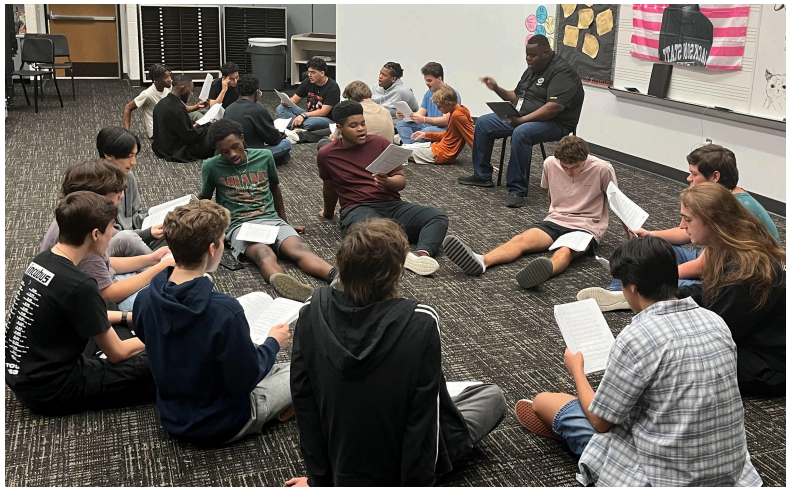
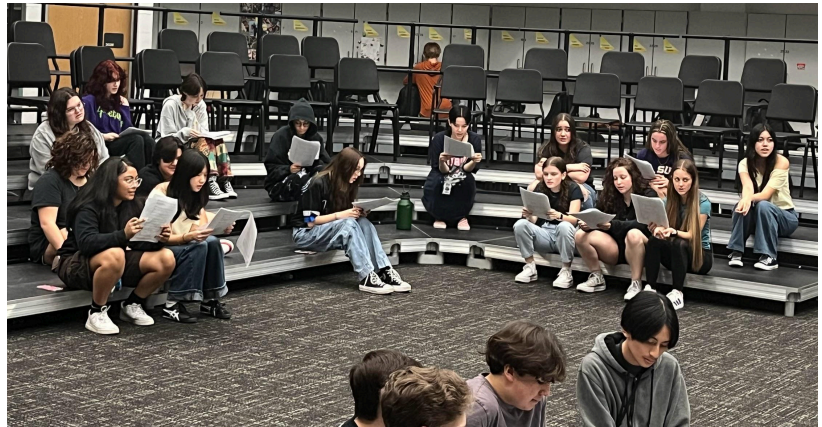

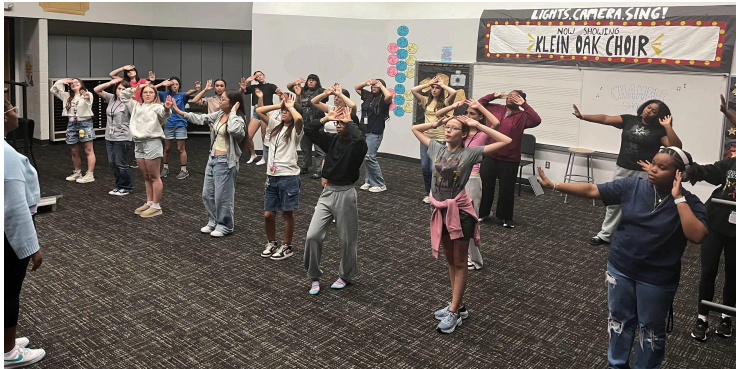


Ambassador Update
